

BAGWORMS



Bagworms are a major pest to be concerned with in summer. They are an extremely common pest in this area and can be found primarily on conifers, especially Leyland Cypress, Arborvitae and Juniper. These insects cause damage to individual branches and can cause serious defoliation if not treated. Bagworms can be found on deciduous trees as well but damage is usually not as serious. These pests are easily identified by the hanging “bag” on twigs that is woven from parts of the plant. Look for these hanging brown bags on your plants in June and through the summer. If you see any signs of bagworms on your plants, give us a call so that we can prevent any further damage.
